#### From the Cantor's Desk:

We currently are in a period on the Jewish calendar referred to as "the Three Weeks." This is a period of mourning that runs from the 17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz (starting the evening of July 22 this year) through the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av (starting the evening of August 12<sup>th</sup>). Each of the first and last days of this period are marked by fasts that commemorate historical tragedies for the people of Israel starting with the incident of the golden calf causing Moses to break the tablets to the report of the spies that results in the Israelites 40-year sojourn in the desert. The mourning intensifies from the first of Av until the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av, the day on which it is believed both he first and second Temples were destroyed resulting first in partial exile and finally exile of almost all of the Jews from Jerusalem. Various other tragedies are also ascribed to this day, such as the expulsion of Jews from England in 1290, the final expulsion of Jews from Spain in 1492 and the start of the liquidation from the Warsaw Ghetto in 1942.

According to the Talmud, these tragedies that started with the golden calf came to their climax with the final destruction of the rebuilt Temple not because of idol worship, lack of following mitzvot or meanness to those less fortunate, but because of "baseless hatred (*sin'at chinam*). Mishna Tractate Yoma explains that this wanton hatred is equivalent to the sins that led to the destruction of the first temple: idol worship, bloodshed and depravity.

As we enter this election cycle, I hope we all will keep in mind what we have that will be destroyed by wanton and baseless hatred. Voices from right and the left play on tropes to stir up hatred against others that can only be viewed as baseless, and Jews always seem to be a convenient target. With all the warfare and civil rights abuses going on in the world, what country's athletes need 24/7 bodyguards other than Israel. Jews are not the only targets of the hate being fomented, but our history is a good example of the results and one of the reasons why we of all people need not only to avoid participating in this kind of wanton hatred, but also to actively fight against it. What sacred institutions will be destroyed if we allow the spread of hatred unchecked.

#### **HADASSAH**

Jerusalem, Israel – The Hadassah Cancer Research Institute (HCRI) has achieved a major breakthrough in personalized cancer care: the development of a neural embedding model that uses machine learning, a kind of artificial intelligence (AI), as well as natural language processing (NLP) to detect dominant mutational signatures in targeted gene panels using only a few mutations, making it ideal for everyday clinical use. The research that led to the new model, called MESiCA for "mutational embeddings for signatures identification in clinical assays," is described in an article in the journal *Cell Reports Medicine*.

"MESiCA represents a major leap forward in personalized medicine," said Dr. Michal Lotem, head of HCRI. "This innovative model offers a practical tool for oncologists, enabling them to make more informed decisions, ultimately leading to improved patient outcomes."

The Hadassah Cancer Research Institute is the transitional research arm for oncology for the **Hadassah Medical Organization**, a leading teaching and research hospital system in Jerusalem.


