## From the Cantor's Desk:

Cantor Marilyn Selby Okoshi:

It's been a year since I first wrote in the Bulletin. I feel privileged to have had the opportunity to get to know the congregation and look forward to sharing more with you all. When I was growing up, my sister and I attended Shabbat services regularly all year, but not in the summer. We did not go to summer camp, but somehow our synagogue attendance was a school year activity, September to June. This year, I have a similar feeling with the high holidays falling in October, it feels like we have a chance to focus in on the month of Elul and really prepare with full mindfulness.

Elul is the last month prior to Rosh Hashanah, our spiritual new year. It is customary to sound the shofar every weekday morning, start the process of asking for forgiveness, visit the graves of our loved ones who have passed and check in with ourselves to take stock. The Chassidic rabbi Schneur Zalman of Liadi likened Elul to the time when the "king is in the field" – meaning that unlike when the king was in royal residence, and audiences with the king are difficult to get, when the king is in the field, anyone can easily approach and speak with the sovereign.

As we approach Elul and the holidays this year, I hope you will take stock of your physical and spiritual well-being and desires. I encourage you to take advantage of the programs and opportunities we offer to increase your knowledge of Judaism and spiritual connection. Whether that is our social programs or educational programs, we are here for you with group and individual learning opportunities. Let us help be the antidote to the loneliness epidemic.


